## Sponsorship levels and How the Funds May be Used

Title Sponsors (\$20K+)



Provides three high school students experiencing homelessness with a full year of rental assistance and support services so they can remain in school and graduate with their class.

Visionary leaders (\$10K+)



Ten teenagers receive a safe haven, warm bed, food, and round-the-clock support for four nights at Second Story for Teens in Crisis, or ten young women at the Second Story for Young Mothers program receive eight months of therapy.

Mission Ambassadors (\$5K+)



Provides 10 teens with daily counseling during their three-week stay at Second Story for Teens in Crisis, or 200 counseling sessions for the children and teens who are at-risk and participating in our after-school programs.

Helping Hands (SIK+)



Thirty teens receive a therapy session at Second Story for Teens in Crisis, or 10 young mothers and their children at Second Story for Young Mothers receive two weeks of food.




