Second Story's Beacon of Hope Fundraiser

Westwood Country Club, Vienna VA

EVENT GOALS:

Second Story's Annual Beacon of Hope Fundraiser Breakfast raises much needed financial and community support. We are striving for a full house of guests who are eager to support our mission, and with your help, we can do that! With this in mind, we have compiled information to help you be a successful Table Host.

TABLE HOST RESPONSIBILITIES:

Invite and confirm the attendance of nine or more people (each table seats 10), and make sure they are registered by Monday, October 13th. Please note that there will be minimal exceptions after this date, as we have a limited number of seats available. We kindly ask that you be mindful that our team is small and has limited capacity—fewer last-minute registrations help us avoid scrambling to finalize details. Also, while you are not required to pay for your guests' seats (all spots are free), please remember that this is a fundraiser. We ask that you ensure your guests are aware of this in advance.

TABLE HOST STEPS TO SUCCESS:

- 1. Invite guests: If you get more than nine confirmations, great! We kindly ask that you keep us updated with the names of your confirmed guests—a simple list will suffice. This helps us keep track and stay organized.
- 2. **Communicate expectations:** Please note, that there is no cost to attend. However, this is a fundraising event. Guests will be encouraged to make a donation, and there will be a direct ask for support during the program.
- 3. Registering guests: You can register your guests or have them register at www.second-story.org once registration opens. The deadline for registration is October 13th. As stated above, there will be limited exceptions, so please get people registered in advance.
- 4. Check in regularly and follow up: We recommend you send a reminder to your guests one week before, as well as the day before the event. If they say they can't come, please let us know so we can update their RSVP.
- 5. At the event: The event starts at 8:00 AM but registration opens at 7:30 AM. Please try to arrive no later than 7:15 AM so you can welcome your guests. You will serve as the representative for Second Story at your table during the event. When the call for donations is made, you as the Table Host will collect the checks and forms at your table and submit the provided envelope to the Table Host station after the event.

You know your guests better than we do! If you are familiar with the person you are inviting, this can and should be personalized. This is just a helpful template.
